Forest School Tool Use Policy

Tools are used within forest school as a way of enhancing sessions and supporting a child's holistic development. Each tool is used for specific purposes and before using any tool, staff will give a 'tool talk' that explains the use and safety procedures for each tool. Staff will model correct and safe tool use and closely monitor children whilst they are using any tool. Children will not be permitted to use tools until the forest school leaders are confident that they can use them safely. Tools will be removed if correct safety procedure is not being followed. When not in use, all tools are stored securely away in a locked shed on the forest school site.
