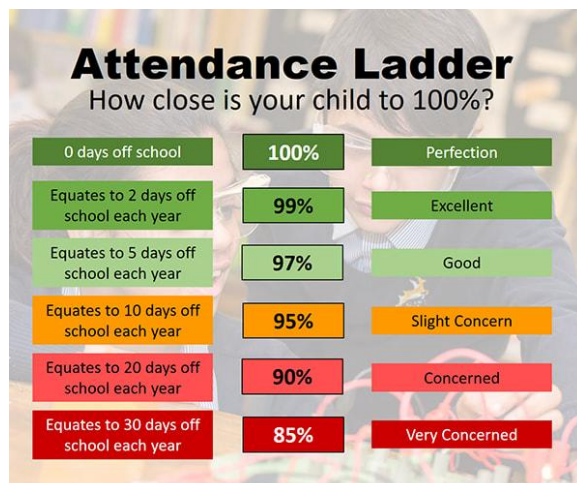
## Attendance News

A huge thank you to everyone who attended school every day and on time last half term. Our attendance last half term was 95.86% and we want to maintain this or even improve it as the year progresses. We believe we can achieve this with your help!

Please remember:

- If your child misses one day this is one phonic sound, new maths learning and a writing skill that they have missed.
- If your child is absent from school for a week, they miss 4 phonic sounds, a unit of writing and a weeks' worth of maths lessons.
- If they are frequently absent on a Friday, they may rarely do PE or science or RE with their friends.

We want all our children to enjoy school and keep up with their learning rather than having to catch up. We understand that illnesses cannot be helped but if you are unsure if they are well enough to attend, please ask us, we will always contact you if we feel that they are too ill for school.
