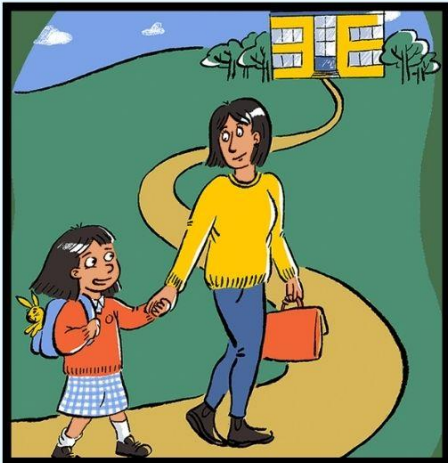

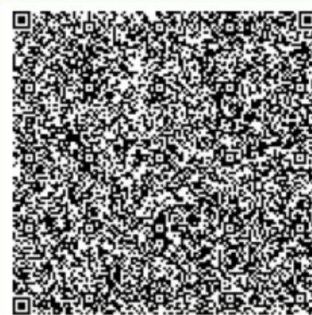
Ready Steady go to School
