# Bird Watching



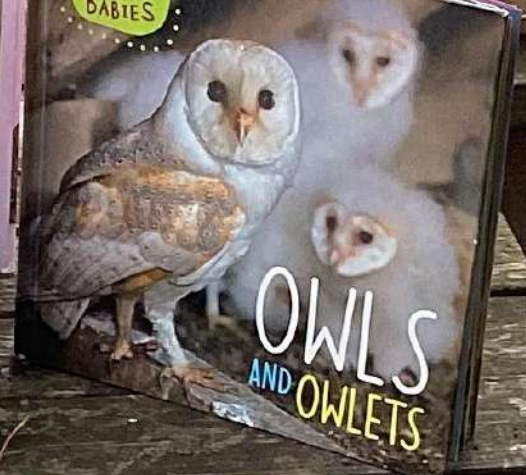
Identifying the different species of birds that live on our site
