Your child has brought home **two books of raffle tickets**, with **5 tickets per book**. Tickets are **£1 each**, meaning a full book costs **£5**. We have some fantastic prizes up for grabs, generously donated by local businesses and supporters.

Please return **completed ticket stubs and payment to school by Wednesday 8 July**. Any **unsold raffle tickets should also be returned by this date**.

This year, all games and activities at the Summer Fair will operate using a token system. Tokens cost **£1 each** and will be used to take part in games and activities throughout the fair. Tokens can be purchased in advance from the **Infant School playground on Fridays from 26 June, between 3:00pm and 4:00pm**. Tokens will also be available to purchase on the day of the fair. We can accept **cash or card payments** for advance token purchases.

We can also take **card payments for raffle tickets at Freezer Friday's**.

Please note that **refreshments and raffle tickets at the fair can be purchased using cash or card**, while **all games and activities will require tokens**.
